I am so excited to announce that **DanceFuzion** has been chosen to take part in **Go Dance 08**, a community dance festival at The Theatre Royal in Glasgow.

Juniors 2, Seniors & Adults of **DanceFuzion** will be performing on this fab stage on Friday 1st February. The Dress Rehearsal takes place earlier on the same day in The Theatre Royal. I will be running a bus to and from the theatre. Parents may also travel on the bus but I believe only appointed chaperones will be allowed into the Dress Rehearsal. **Please let me know asap if you wish to travel on the bus.**

I require 4-5 chaperones backstage as pupils 16yrs & under are required to be chaperoned at all times. Could anyone interested in being a chaperone please let me know. They must be over 18 and will not be able to watch **DanceFuzion's** performance.

As you will see from the times, school pupils will be required to get permission to leave school at lunchtime. I have included a copy of the letter from The Theatre Royal requesting permission for the pupil to attend the Dress Rehearsal. **Please take this letter to school.**

Adult dancers will be required to make arrangements to get away from work/college.

There will be **no charge for dancers/chaperones** and they will be given tickets on the day to enable them to watch the act which they are not performing in. They must be chaperoned at all times.
